PART II

We realize that participation in any high school activity may involve the potential for injury which is inherent in all sports/activities. We acknowledge that even with the best coaching/supervision, use of the most advanced protective equipment and strict observance of rules, injuries are still a possibility. On rare occasions these injuries can be so severe as to result in total disability, paralysis or even death.

We also understand that Star Valley High School does NOT carry medical or dental insurance on students and that there is an optional Accident Insurance plan we may buy personally. Forms for this personal insurance are available at the high school or the school district office.

PART III

The administration and staff of Star Valley High School feel that maintaining and demonstrating good character traits are a valuable part of a person's high school career. The following rules have been established to ensure that those students who are representing Star Valley High School reflect these high standards.

- No student on any activity from Star Valley High School will use, sell, distribute, be in possession of, or under the influence of: tobacco, alcohol, narcotics or drugs (including marijuana).
- Students who fail to dress appropriately or demonstrate good citizenship as deemed by the chaperon, bus driver or supervising teacher, will be subject to disciplinary action by the school administration. This may mean suspension from school or suspension from future participation in school activities.
- No girls shall be allowed in boys' rooms, nor boys in girls' rooms, on any activity.
- Any student violating the law while on a Star Valley High School activity will be turned over to the police. This includes offenses for shoplifting, vandalism, drugs or alcohol abuse, etc.

SVHS Eligibility and Training Code

There may be other rules, guidelines or applicable constitutions determined by the respective club, group or other competitive organization and/or the advisors and the administration of the high school.

Section I – Health Standard

No use, possession of tobacco in ANY form. No use of, sale of, distribution of, possession of, being under the influence of narcotics, drugs, controlled substances, or alcohol. If you are with a group that is breaking your training rules, you will be considered guilty. The consequence for failing to abide by these health standards is immediate dismissal from the team, group or class office for the remainder of the season. Any letter, honors or post season recognition will be denied. Coaches and administrators reserve the right to NOT write a letter of recommendation for post high school purposes based on a violation of this code.

Section II – Academic Standard

Maintain a passing grade in all classes during the season. Eligibility will be determined on a weekly basis. Students will be warned and given one week to work closely with the teacher in correcting academic problems. If the student is still not passing a class for the second week in a row, they will be suspended from that week's event. Students will remain suspended until the following week's eligibilities are run. Eligibility reports are run on Mondays at 3:30pm. Also, if a student is caught cheating, he/she is ineligible for that week's event.

If ineligible for three weeks during the season or caught cheating a second time, that student will be dismissed from the group.

Students should get homework from teachers BEFORE leaving on trips.

Section III – Good Citizenship Standard

The student will avoid suspension or other disciplinary action for misbehavior or truancy. Skipping released time classes, or failing to check out of school properly in the office, is considered unexcused. Misbehavior includes any conduct on or off the court that would bring embarrassment to the team or school.

Consequences of such an offence: 1st time – Student will miss one game or activity. 2nd time – Same as first, plus disciplinary action by the coach or sponsor. The administration will be notified what the disciplinary action was. 3rd time – Dismissal from the team.

Section IV – Other Rules

Each coach or sponsor will list any additional rules which apply to his/her sport or group with the consequence of violation for each rule. Each coach or sponsor reserves the right to remove any student from his/her team or group at his/her discretion.

1. No boys will be allowed in girls' rooms, nor girls in boys' rooms, on any trip.
2. Curfew hours will be communicated and enforced.
3. Other rules may apply.
