

# SVHS Graduation Requirements

Welcome to Star Valley High School! The purpose of this document is to help you understand the credit requirements to graduate from Star Valley High School. Also included are the requirements for the Hathaway Scholarship.

## Important information to understand:

- \* Each course earns .5 credits. (course = 1 class period for 1 trimester)
- \* On the Trimester schedule, students could earn 36 credits over 4 years.  
(6 courses per trimester = 3 credits X 3 trimesters = 9 credits/year)

## Credits required to receive SVHS diploma:

Class of:           **2025 needs 29 credits** (14.5 required + 14.5 elective) **to graduate.**  
                          **2026 needs 30 credits** (14.5 required + 15.5 elective) **to graduate.**  
                          **2027 (and beyond) needs 31 credits** (14.5 required + 16.5 elective) **to graduate.**

## Required Classes/Subjects

<b>English:</b>	Eng IA/IB, Eng IIA/IIB, Eng IIIA/IIIB, Eng IVA/IVB	(8 courses = 4 credits)
<b>Math:</b>	Alg IA/IB, Geometry A/B, Alg IIA/IIB (or equivalent)	(6 courses = 3 credits)
<b>Science:</b>	Physical Science A/B, Biology A/B, 2 additional	(6 courses = 3 credits)
<b>Social Studies:</b>	World History A/B, American History A/B, Government, Economics	(6 courses = 3 credits)
<b>Other:</b>	Health, PE, Freshman Leadership (Class of 2028 and beyond)	(3 courses = 1.5 credits)
<b>Total <i>REQUIRED</i> courses/credits:</b>		<b><u>29 courses = 14.5 credits</u></b>

## ELECTIVE Credits Needed:

Class of **2025:**                   **14.5 credits** (equates to 29 elective courses)  
Class of **2026:**                   **15.5 credits** (equates to 30 elective courses)  
Class of **2027**(and beyond):   **16.5 credits** (equates to 31 elective courses)

\* Some electives courses can be repeated for credit, while others cannot. Please check with the counselors to make sure the electives you take will earn credit.

Effective July 1, 2021, students can take any HSC approved course/s **prior** to ninth grade and qualify towards the Hathaway Success Curriculum

- \* Students who earn an associate's degree can extend for an additional 4 full-time semesters at UW.
- \*\* All AP, IB and dual/concurrent courses (+1000 level and above) will be weighted.
- \*\*\* Two of the four years must be sequenced. Sequenced courses follow the same CTE career cluster OR CTE program of study.
