

## **SVHS ADMINISTRATION**

Parents and students, we just wanted to say congratulations and thanks to everyone as we worked through our WyTopp and ACT tests this Spring. We are grateful for your support of SVHS. Our 10th Grade Math increased again for the second year in a row with 55% being proficient or advanced. Very impressive! 10th grade science was 18% above the state average with 66% being proficient or advanced. Impressive as well! 10th grade English was above the state average by 15%! 66% of them scored at proficient or advanced. Great job sophomores and teachers! 9th grade math had 55% of our students proficient or advanced. Very impressive! That is 13% above the state.

Thanks again to our parents, students, and teachers for helping to make SVHS a great place to be. 9th grade English scored 77% that were proficient or advanced. At this point we believe this will be the top score in the state for large high schools. Great job freshman and teachers!

Graduation is right around the corner, on May 29th—crazy how fast time flies by as we get ready to wrap up another great school year!
