STUDENT COUNCIL

Our theme for May is: “Making It Count”

Every day at SVHS is a chance to make it count. Whether it’s showing up to class, helping a friend, competing, performing, or pushing yourself to do a little better than yesterday, the small choices you make matter. High school goes by faster than you think, so take the opportunities, make the memories, and give your best effort. Be involved, be kind, and be proud of the legacy you leave—because these moments count.

Recently, our high school students attended an assembly on internet safety and responsible social media use, featuring Special Agent Dustin Richards from the Wyoming Department of Criminal Investigations. He shared real-world examples to help students understand how teens can be manipulated or exploited online and emphasized the importance of protecting personal information, recognizing warning signs, and speaking up if something feels wrong. Students were encouraged to use privacy settings, be cautious when interacting with others online, and reach out to a trusted adult for help. Families are encouraged to continue these conversations at home, and additional support is available through the National Center for Missing & Exploited Children's CyberTipline at <https://www.missingkids.org/gethelpnow/cybertipline>.

In addition, LCSD #2 School Board President Darnell Simpson shared an important presentation during the April Board Meeting, highlighting a valuable resource for our community and families.
